

What is a conveyance?

Simply put, a conveyance is changing the registration of real estate with the land title office. Depending on why the title is changing, your conveyancer will also:

- Meet with you to review and sign all paperwork.
- Investigate the title of the property, including judgments registered against it, liens, taxes due, or other encumbrances.
- Register or discharge any mortgages.
- Obtain mortgage funds from a lender and apply them to the purchase.
- Oversee the transfer of funds from the buyer to the seller.

What to expect

Your realtor or mortgage broker will send the documents to Clark Woods to initiate the process. We follow up with you to collect any other documents and arrange a time for an in-person meeting.

At the meeting, the lawyer will verify your ID. Then the lawyer will go through every document that requires a signature with you, explaining them and answering any questions.

Once you have signed all the documents, you're done! From there, the lawyer will correspond with the lawyer or notary on the other side to complete the transaction.


Do I need a cohabitation or co-ownership agreement?
